The purpose of the Junior Committee is to organise golf activities (coaching, competitions and matches) for girls at all levels within the county and to promote golf as a sport to girls of all ages.

Committee Members

Job Title	Role
County Junior Organiser	To promote golf for girls in Oxfordshire and co-ordinate the organisation of golf activities for girls within the county.
Junior Secretary	To assist in the administrative duties relating to activities for girls' golf in the county.
Junior Competition Secretary	To assist in the organisation of competitions for girls.
Junior Team Manager	To arrange matches and provide match experience for girls in the county.
Junior Training Officer	To arrange and manage coaching for intermediate and advanced girls within the county.
Junior Liaison Officer	To build communication pathways with organisations outside OLCGA for the mutual development of girls' golf.
Junior Beginners' Organiser	To organise coaching and activities for girls in the county who are new to golf and to encourage girls to take up the game of golf.
County Welfare Officer	To ensure that OLCGA has a comprehensive child protection policy and procedures and that these are adhered to in all OLCGA activities.

These roles have been given individual job titles to ensure that all aspects of junior activity covered and to try to make each role smaller and more manageable. However, it is not necessary for each of them to be undertaken by different people, one person could, and probably will, take on more than one role depending on their skills, interests and available free time.
